

## MGT 406: Community Threat Group Identification, Assessment and Information Reporting for Rural Law Enforcement Officers

MGT 406 is an 8-hour, DHS/FEMA-certified, tuition-free, management-level course. This course takes a comprehensive approach to examining threat groups in rural communities, with a particular focus on the nexus of gangs, hate groups, domestic and international terrorist organizations as they converge for criminal enterprise.

Through this course, students will learn to identify the criminal activities of Community Threat Groups (CTG) and networks that impact rural communities across the country; classify domestic and international community threat groups based on institutionalization, sophistication, and likelihood for convergence; and, use a Suspicious Activity Report (SAR) to report suspicious activity carried out by CTGs in and around rural communities.

Topics include (but not limited to):

- Forensics and Attribution
- Intelligence and Information Sharing
- Interdiction and Disruption
- Operations Coordination
- Planning
- Public Information and Warning
- Screening, Search, and Detection
- Threat and Hazard Identification
